

Unicable Manufacturing Status and Coronavirus

Dear Unicable Customer:

We would like to take a moment to update our customers on the manufacturing facility's status regarding the Coronavirus and how it has affected reopening after Chinese New Year.

As of now, the government has allowed a small crew to return consisting of a handful of office staff and approx. 30 production workers. They must stand at a minimum of 2 Meters apart and all the while wearing infection control equipment while working. It has made production slow and challenging. It has not even allowed production to return to 10% capacity. Each week they must continue to submit a plan to the government to exhibit that the plan is working and controlling disease and hope that they will continue to allow for the workforce to grow. Most of the transit is closed and not much movement is allowed around, thus the returning workers from outside provinces are also finding it difficult to return to work as soon as they are granted permission. In addition, many of the material suppliers are suffering the same issue. They are closed or reopened under the same strict conditions. There are many difficulties being faced by the manufacturing plant at this time. As we have new updates, we will continue to update our customers.

We appreciate your patience during this time as they progress back to full capacity, however, we do anticipate up to a month of delay in all new and existing orders and we will get orders confirmed as soon as we possibly can. Unicable staff will continue to update you as much as possible as new information is provided to us by the factory.
